# DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND COMMUNITY SUPERVISION: ALTERNATIVE VISITATION ARRANGEMENT

## **Description of Program and Relief**

Effective March 14, 2020 until April 11, 2020, the Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS) suspends visitation at facilities statewide, as a result of community transmission of COVID-19 in New York. Legal visits will not be impacted by this visitation suspension but will be non-contact.

To reduce the impact of this visitation restriction, DOCCS provides incarcerated individuals five (5) free stamps per week to mail letters, two (2) free secured calls via electronic tablets per week and one (1) free telephone call per week.
